Complexity of Medical Decision Making

# of Dx or manage options	Amount &/or complexity of data	Risk of complication &/or M&M	Type of decision making
minimal	minimal	minimal	Straight-forward
limited	limited	low	Low
multiple	moderate	moderate	Moderate
extensive	extensive	high	High complexity

Moderate level of risk - examples

1 or more chronic illnesses w/ mild exacerbation

2 or more stable chronic illnesses

Undx'd new problem w/ uncertain prognosis (breast lump)

Acute illness with systemic sx's (pyelo, pneumonia, colitis)

Acute complicated injury (head inj with brief LOC)

Welcome to Medicare

G0403

1. In the first 12 months of Medicare
2. Must include components of CPE

AND

- a. Potential for depression
- b. Functional ability/risk of falls
- c. Vision and hearing screen
- d. Screening and preventive care plan

EKG no longer necessary

First CPE if no intro to Medicare done

G0438

1. Must be in Medicare at least 1 year
2. Usual CPE documentation

AND

- a. List of specialists
- b. Potential for depression
- c. Vision/hearing evaluation
- d. Cognitive evaluation
- e. Functional ability/risk of fall
- f. Advanced directives
- g. Screening/preventive care plan

Subsequent CPE or did have intro exam

G0439

Must be at least 1 year after prior CPE

Same documentation as G0438

Home Care Supervision

G0180

Physician certification for Medicare-covered home health services under a home health plan of care (pt not present) including contacts with home health agency and review of reports of patient status required by physicians to affirm the initial implementation of the plan of care that meets the patient's needs per cert period (60 days).

G0179

Re-certification. Every 60 days.
